

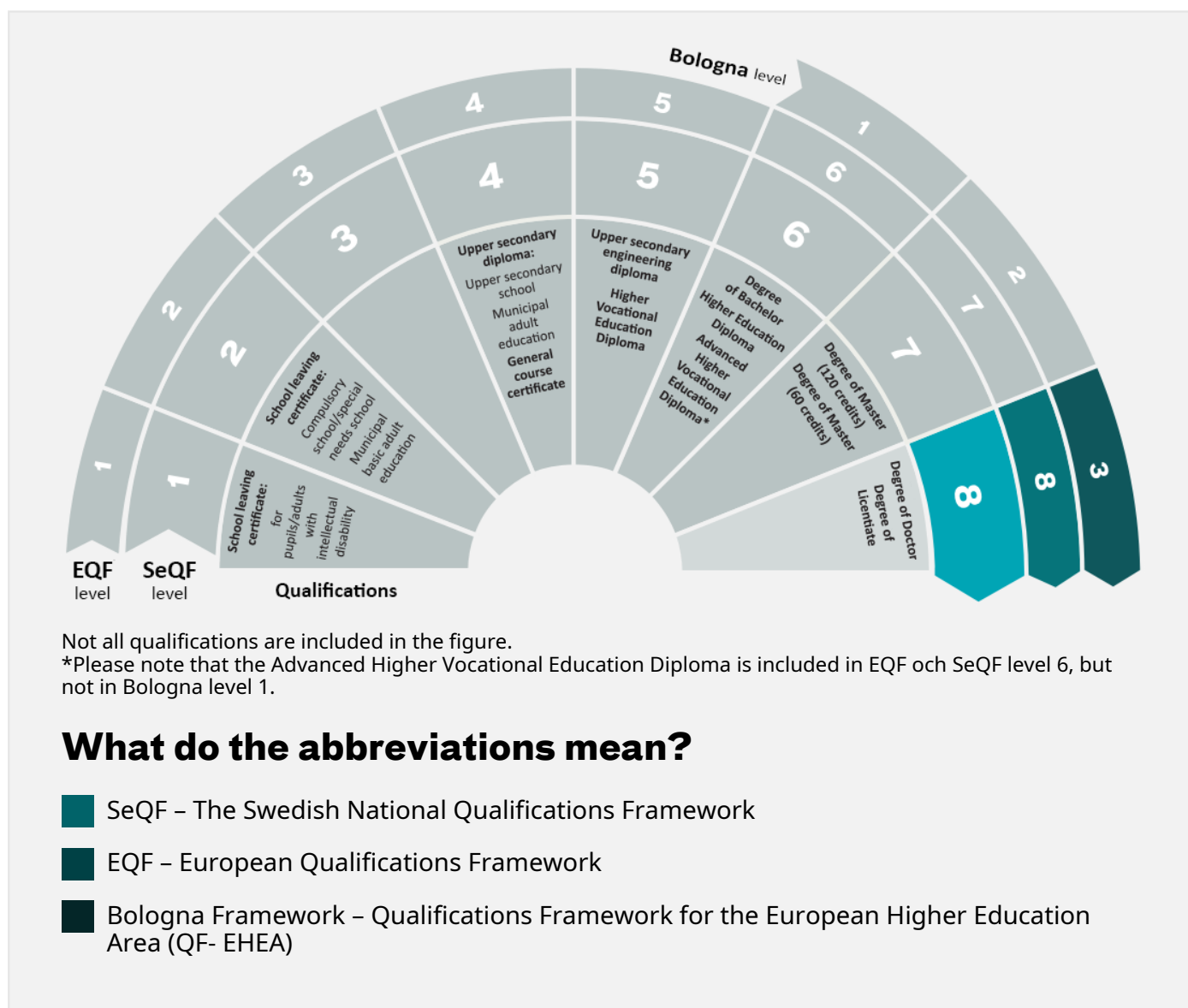

<b>Duration</b>	3 years
<b>ECTS</b>	180 credits
<b>Information about the qualification</b>	<p>The qualification was introduced in 2005. There are also qualification pre-2005 with the same degree title that receive the same assessment.</p> <p>The qualification includes courses, research and a thesis that has been defended at a public defence.</p>
<b>National Qualifications Framework (NQF)</b>	<p><a href="#">Armenian National Qualifications Framework</a></p> <p>The national qualifications framework (The Armenian NQF) has 8 levels, where 1 is the lowest and 8 is the highest.</p>
<b>NQF level</b>	8 (The Armenian NQF)
<b>Recognised higher education institutions</b>	<p><a href="#">ANQA - Institutional accreditation state register</a></p> <p>Please note the country can have additional recognised education institutions.</p>
<b>Country information</b>	<p>Armenia is a full member of the Bologna Process, but has not yet completed the process of the European higher education area (QF-EHEA).</p>
